# While On Charger Flash red every 5 seconds Charging (in service) Charged While Off Charger Flash red every 10 seconds During A Call Solid blue Normal

### Water-Resistant:

Zoey is water-resistant and should be worn in the shower. However, the device should not be submerged. Always towel-dry after exposure to water.

### Pacemakers:

# To Change From Lanyard to Belt Clip

- **1.** Turn the pendant so the call button faces you. With your thumb, push the lanyard attachment away from you until the lanyard clicks off.
- **2.** Place the horizontal piece of the clip on top of the pendant so that the notches on the pendant and the clip line up.
- **3.** Press the clip into the pendant until it slides securely into place.

**Note:** You can charge Zoey in its cradle with the belt clip attached.



# Important: Fully Charge Before First Use

- **1.** Plug in the charging cradle and place Zoey into the cradle as shown. The light will flash red every 5 seconds while charging and becomes solid red when fully charged.
- **2.** Typical charging time is 2-3 hours.
- **3.** If the battery is low, the light will slowly flash red when off the charging cradle. Also, the device will state, "Battery low, please charge" if you press the call button; it will then place the call.

Note: Battery life will vary between 6 – 16 days, depending on the mode utilized. Only charge as needed. If you have trouble charging Zoey, wipe the connecting pins with rubbing alcohol to clean debris.

# Test your system every week.







Press and hold the alert button until the light turns blue.

You will hear a message, then a tone, before being connected to the Command Center.

The Command Center will send help unless you inform them that you're testing.

For those with **Fall Detection**, your pendant can automatically send an alert if it senses a fall, based on speed, impact, and lack of movement. However, we do recommend pressing your button whenever possible.
